## 05.09.2023: Egor Litvinenko with double victory in Porsche Sports Cup!!!

## **Porsche Sports Cup Nürburgring**

Last weekend Egor Litvinenko contested his second guest start in the Porsche Sports Cup Germany. Normally the young German licensed driver competes in the GTC race. To bridge this year's very long summer break of almost 10 weeks, Egor and his team decided to participate in the Porsche Sports Cup races during this time. After an impressive performance in Oschersleben where Egor could already achieve a race victory, the team traveled full of anticipation and zest for action to the Nürburgring on the first weekend in September.

After a changeable Friday with lots of rain, the Eifel showed itself from its most beautiful side on Saturday. Just in time for qualifying it cleared up and the track dried. Since the lap times improved every lap and Egor was the first to finish qualifying, the Allied Porsche with the number 126 ended up in 3rd place on the grid.

The first race started furiously, Egor took his two opponents by surprise with a daring maneuver directly in the first corner. After a counterattack by a competitor, he came back from the first lap in second place. After two longer safety car phases Egor used the first chance he had and took the lead again at the start-finish. At the end of the 30 minutes Race the beaming winner was Egor Litvinenko. On Sunday a similar picture. Right at the start Egor attacked his rivals and overtook both of them directly in the first lap. From then on, Egor drove a safe race, which he finally won with a lead of more than eight seconds. As in the first race, he also secured the fastest race lap by a wide margin.

After the race, Egor Litvinenko made the following comments: "I am very happy and thank my team Allied Racing and my supporters."

Robin Landgraf from RL-Competition, who accompanied Egor personally this time, was full of praise for his protégé: "Egor has had a great development. He has become a really professional racer and performed great in both races."

In mid-October, Egor will next contest the season finale of the GTC Race at the Nürburgring.
