After the tests, the 2024 program for Egor was quickly found! It will be a Porsche GT3 Cup car. The collaboration with Allied Racing will continue. And the goal of the Porsche Carrera Cup will be proclaimed.

Robin Landgraf, who advises and looks after Egor, explains the season planning: "Egor has shown an impressive learning curve this season. The tests in the Cup car were so promising that we want to continue working on this platform. However, we have great respect for the power density in the Carrera Cup Germany and therefore want to give Egor the opportunity to prove himself in the Porsche Sports Cup Germany first and gain important experience there before entering the Carrera Cup later in the year. Allied Racing offers us every opportunity to organize the season and train Egor specifically on the Cup car!"

Jan Kasperlik, Team Principal of Allied Racing, said: "Despite Egor's impressive test performances, we want to give him the opportunity to slowly prepare for the Carrera Cup in the Sports Cup. We have the best basis there to train him further and shape him into a professional racing driver."

Porsche Motorsport itself is currently developing the Sports Cup into a young talent platform for the Carrera Cup. In addition to a live stream for all races, there will be a talent pool there next year, similar to the Carrera Cup, which will support and accompany young up-and-coming drivers. The main prize of a Porsche Tycan for the series winner rounds off the new package and made it easy for Egor and his advisor to decide on this program.
