01.05.2023: Egor Litvinenko with successful GTC season opener in Hockenheim!!!

GTC RACE Hockenheim

Young Egor Litvinenko is competing in the GT4 Championship of the GTC Race again this year, as he did in the 2022 season. Hockenheim was the venue for the first race here last weekend.

After extensive winter tests and specific preparations in the simulator of Allied Racing, the team that runs Egor's Porsche Porsche GT4 RS, the young Russian, who lives in Switzerland, travelled to the Hockenheimring full of anticipation and highly motivated.

Already the practice sessions showed that the hard work during the winter had paid off, Egor was always in the Top 10 within striking distance of the absolute top group. In the first qualifying session there was a small setback in the form of a puncture. However, the Allied team reacted very quickly and put the Porsche back on the track within a very short time, enabling Egor to at least limit the damage a little with P10.

Sunday's races were characterised by tough fights for positions and very close results. The GTC series impressed the audience with a strong field of 23 GT4 cars. The colourful mix of professional drivers and young upcoming drivers makes the series particularly exciting. Egor showed in both sprint races on Sunday flawless and spirited races. In the first sprint he reached 8th place after losing a few positions in the final phase. After the race analysis with his engineer and the briefing with his coach, Egor went into the second sprint race full of fight. Already at the start he was able to make up some places and fought for the podium positions until the end of the race. In the end, Egor finished in 5th place, which made him and the whole team around Allied Racing and RL-Competition very happy.

Robin Landgraf, who has been looking after Egor for 10 years and has also accompanied him on his way in motor racing, was also thrilled: "Egor has made a huge step! We are now right at the front and can fight for top placings under our own steam. My special thanks go to Allied Racing who, in addition to professional engineering, do a great job in training the drivers and offer Egor a professional environment!
