September 17, 2025: ADAC GT4 Germany – Red Bull Ring – Egor Litvinenko finishes in the top 10 in Spielberg

Last weekend, ADAC GT4 Germany made a guest appearance at the historic Red Bull Ring in Austria as part of the DTM. Munich-based racing driver Egor Litvinenko was also there, competing for the Austrian Wimmer Werk Motorsport Team in a Porsche Cayman GT4 RS.

Solid qualifying, strong races

Qualifying did not go perfectly for Litvinenko. With starting positions of 17th and 15th, he fell slightly short of expectations. Nevertheless, the mood in the team was positive – the Porsche's race pace gave cause for hope for the two races.

Litvinenko confirmed these hopes in the first race on Saturday. Starting from 15th on the grid, he got off to a flying start: he overtook several competitors in the first two corners and found himself in 11th place after the opening lap. Although he lost a few positions as the race progressed, he secured a solid result for the team with 15th place.

Top 10 result in Sunday's race

On Sunday, the Munich native once again showed his fighting spirit. After another strong start, he steadily worked his way up the field. In the last ten minutes of the hour-long race, Litvinenko staged an impressive comeback: starting from 12th place, he overtook several opponents and ultimately crossed the finish line in ninth place. In doing so, he achieved his declared goal for the weekend – a top 10 finish.

Looking ahead

"That was a very important result for me and the whole team," said a happy Litvinenko after the race. "We showed that we have the pace to compete at the front. We can build on that."

With momentum on his side, the Munich native now travels to the big season finale of the ADAC GT4 Germany, which will be held at the Hockenheimring in early October. There, Litvinenko wants to attack once again and finish the season with another strong result.
