



Egor Litvinenko Continues Upward Trend at the Nürburgring

Last weekend, ADAC GT4 Germany visited the Nürburgring as part of the DTM programme. Following significant progress at the previous events, Egor Litvinenko and his teammate Oskar Dix travelled to the Eifel region highly motivated. Their objective was clear: to continue their upward trend and take the next step towards becoming regular top-10 contenders.

The young driver pairing demonstrated the potential of their Porsche GT4 RS right from the practice sessions. After finishing second in the opening session and third in the third session, Litvinenko and Dix were consistently among the fastest drivers in the field. Expectations for the two qualifying sessions were therefore correspondingly high.

However, Egor was unable to convert his strong practice pace into a similarly impressive qualifying result. He encountered heavy traffic several times during his flying lap, making a better position impossible. In the end, he had to settle for 12th place on the starting grid. Following the promising practice results, this initially came as a small disappointment, but the entire team remained confident.

Oskar Dix took the wheel for the second qualifying session. By securing 13th place on the grid, he also confirmed his positive development.

Litvinenko and Dix began moving forward in the opening race. With a focused and faultless performance, the young duo guided their Porsche to a strong 11th-place finish. Although they narrowly missed out on the top 10, they collected valuable championship points and gained important information for the second race.

On Saturday evening, Wimmer Werk Motorsport made a number of further setup changes to the Porsche. The team's intensive work paid off: Litvinenko and Dix made full use of the car's additional potential in Sunday's second race and delivered an impressive performance to finish ninth.

With this top-10 result, the duo once again confirmed the upward trend that has now been evident over the past two races. Both the drivers' development and the continuous progress with the car's setup have given the entire team plenty of confidence for the remainder of the season.

Team principals Felix and Max Wimmer now regard the Porsche driven by Egor Litvinenko and Oskar Dix as a consistent top-10 contender heading into the final part



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of the season. At the same time, their sights are already set even higher: Wimmer Werk Motorsport intends to take the next step and challenge for the top five in the remaining races.

The next round of ADAC GT4 Germany will take place at the Sachsenring, and preparations for the demanding race weekend are already in full swing. Following their encouraging progress at the Nürburgring, Egor and Oskar will travel to Saxony with renewed confidence and a clear objective: to continue their upward trend and further close the gap to the front of the field.

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
